- The Township of North Kawartha's Community Centres, including the Glen Alda, Wilson Park and North Kawartha Community Centres, along with the Fitness Centre and Arena Surface, will be closed to the public effective at 5:00 p.m. March 16th. All recreation programs and services, will be suspended until further notice.
- North Kawartha Public Libraries, Apsley and Woodview Branches, are closed until April 7th. All March Break programming is cancelled.
