



Unattached Patients: Access to Care during COVID-19

We are happy to share that we have received funding for the continuation of our unattached patient clinics beyond March 31, 2020. Although a formal announcement has yet to be made, this means that the Peterborough Virtual Care Clinic (PVCC) in Peterborough City and the PFHT Clinic located in Lakefield will continue to provide care to our unattached population.

The Peterborough Virtual Care Clinic (PVCC) and the PFHT Clinic in Lakefield are open and available on a restricted basis for unattached patients. Patients seeking care are asked to call to book an appointment, walk-ins will NOT be accepted. The hours of the clinics will flex day to day dependent on COVID-19 precautions as well as demand. Where possible, appointments will take place virtually (either via phone or OTN video conference) in an effort to limit in-person contact. These clinics are available to any residents of Peterborough City or County who do not have access to a local primary care provider. As per policy, narcotic prescriptions are not available to any patients who seek care at these clinics.
