

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
BURLEIGH-ANSTRUTHER -CHANDOS**

**BY-LAW # 51/98**

---

**BEING A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
BURLEIGH-ANSTRUTHER-CHANDOS TO PROHIBIT THE THROWING,  
DEPOSITING OR PLACING OF REFUSE OR DEBRIS ON PROPERTY  
OWNED BY THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BURLEIGH-  
ANSTRUTHER-CHANDOS.**

**WHEREAS** SECTION 210, PARAGRAPH 82 OF THE MUNICIPAL ACT,  
Chapter m 45, R.S.O. 1990 as amended, provides that Councils of local  
Municipalities may pass by-laws to prohibit the throwing, depositing, or placing  
of refuse or debris on property owned by the Municipality;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Township of Burleigh-Anstruther-  
Chandos hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this By-Law;

Litter includes any material left or abandoned in a place other than in an  
approved receptacle or area.

2. No person shall throw, place or deposit any debris, refuse or garbage  
onto any property owned by the Township of Burleigh-Anstruther-  
Chandos that is or likely to become litter.

3. Any person who contravenes this By-law is guilty of an offence and is  
liable upon summary conviction to a fine of no more than FIVE  
THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.) Exclusive of cost and such fine is  
recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.
