Parks & Recreation Updates

The Township of North Kawartha is taking actions to help protect the health of our community during the COVID-19 pandemic. Please visit the Township website's [COVID-19 page](#) to stay informed of additional closures/changes to Township services, amenities, and [programs](#).

To ensure public safety, and be in compliance with [Peterborough Public Health recommendations](#) and [Provincial Government orders](#) that came into effect at 12:01 am on Wednesday, January 05, 2022, the Township must close the [North Kawartha](#), [Wilson Park](#), and [Glen Alda Community Centres](#), which means [programs and/or services](#) at the Community Centres will be suspended. This includes the [Fitness Centre](#), the [NKCC ice surface](#), and all other [programming](#). The proposed date for lifting/changing restrictions is January 26, but is subject to change and will ultimately be determined by the Provincial Government.

And a reminder, as of January 04, 2022, the only acceptable form of Proof of Vaccination is a QR code, which can be obtained at [covid-19.ontario.ca/get-proof](https://www.covid-19.ontario.ca/get-proof), or by calling the Provincial Vaccine Contact Centre at 1-833-943-3900. In addition, the [North Kawartha Public Library](#), Apsley Branch, is assisting residents in obtaining printed copies of their QR code. You may contact the Library at 705-656-4333.

Garbage and Recycling

As [Garbage and Recycling Collection](#) is deemed an essential service, the Anstruther and Haultain Transfer Stations are not affected by the new regulations, and will maintain [regular hours](#).

When exiting your vehicle at our Transfer Stations you are requested to wear a [face covering](#) and maintain physical distancing of 2 metres (six feet), to help protect the health of our Transfer Station attendants, as well as others.

[Curbside Collection](#) will continue as per the normal schedule. To support physical distancing, residents are encouraged to use Curbside Collection.
