Subject: Micro Surfacing Tender (T-01-2026)

### **Recommendation:**

That Council authorize staff to enter into an agreement with Miller Paving Limited for the provision of micro surfacing services in accordance with Bid Number T-01-2026, issued through the County of Peterborough's 2026 group purchasing tender.

### **Background:**

Township staff included designated roads for micro surfacing in the County of Peterborough's 2026 group purchasing tender. The roads identified for the Township of North Kawartha are Cheboutequion Drive and Napier Crescent.

### **Analysis:**

Three compliant bids were received through the tender process. Miller Paving Limited submitted the lowest bid in the amount of \$80,762.50. The remaining compliant bids were received from Duncor Enterprises Inc. and Greenwood Paving Ltd. Following a review of all submissions, the County of Peterborough confirmed that Miller Paving Limited's bid met all tender requirements and represented the lowest overall cost to the municipality.

### **Financial Implications:**

The cost of the proposed work is within the approved 2026 Capital Budget.
