

The Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha

By-law 2026-000

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha to appoint Keely-Anne Johnson as Deputy Clerk and alternate Lottery Licensing Officer for the Township of North Kawartha

Whereas the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c25, Section 228 (2), as amended provides that a municipality may appoint deputy clerks who have all the powers and duties of the clerk under this and any other Act.

And Whereas The Council for The Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha deems it expedient to appoint Keely-Anne Johnson as Deputy Clerk for the Township of North Kawartha;

And Whereas Order-in-Council 1413/08 as amended and the Gaming Control Act, 1992 and its Regulations gives municipal councils the authority to issue licences;

And whereas it is deemed expedient that the Lottery Licensing Officer carry out the requirements in respect of granting lottery licences on behalf of the municipality for charitable or religious purposes;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha enacts as follows:

1. That Keely-Anne Johnson be appointed as Deputy Clerk for the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha.
2. That Keely-Anne Johnson be appointed as alternate Licensing Officer for the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha and shall perform such duties as prescribed by Provincial and Federal Legislation;
3. That any by-laws contrary to this by-law be hereby repealed, including By-Law 2018-0104.

This by-law shall come into effect on the 1st day of June, 2026.
