I am the CAO for the Township of North Kawartha. I wanted to advise you that I have received a copy of your email from Parks Canada. The Township will place your letter on the November 18, 2025 Council meeting agenda for discussion and direction from Council.

Control of the Trent Severn watershed and water levels is not under the control of the municipality. Parks Canada, the Trent Severn Waterway have that jurisdiction and will be responding to your questions, 1, 2 and 4. The Township does not have any plans to create road access and the area in which your lake is situated is under the jurisdiction of the Kawartha Highlands as a provincial park.
