

The Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha

By-law 2026-0000

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha to appoint Kelly Picken as Clerk and Lottery Licensing Officer for the Township of North Kawartha

Whereas the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c25, Section 228, as amended, provides that the municipality shall appoint a Clerk;

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha is desirous of appointing a Clerk who shall have all the powers and duties as set out under Section 228(1) of the Municipal Act and any other related Act of the Province of Ontario;

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha deem it desirable to appoint a Licensing Officer for the purpose of Lottery Licensing and Licensing and Regulation of certain occupations, trades and businesses in the Township of North Kawartha;

And Whereas , under the authority of Section 23.1 (2) of the Municipal Act, Section 23.1 provides the authority for Council to delegate routine powers and duties with some restrictions.

And Whereas Order-in-Council 1413/08 as amended and the Gaming Control Act, 1992 and its Regulations gives municipal councils the authority to issue licences;

And whereas it is deemed expedient that the Lottery Licencing Officer carry out the requirements in respect of granting lottery licences on behalf of the municipality for charitable or religious purposes;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha enacts as follows:

1. That Kelly Picken be appointed as Clerk for the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha.
2. That Kelly Picken be appointed as Licensing Officer for the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha and shall perform such duties as prescribed by Provincial and Federal Legislation;
3. That any by-laws contrary to this by-law be hereby repealed, including By-Law 2000-0047 and By-Law 2002-0107.

This by-law shall come into effect on the 1st day of June, 2026.
