

The Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha

By-law 2025-000

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha to authorize the execution of a Licence of Occupation agreement between His Majesty the King in Right of Ontario, As represented by the Minister of Environment, Conservations and Parks and the Township of North Kawartha to construct, own and maintain a dock along the shoreline of Rathbun Lake.

Whereas the Municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, Section 9;

And Whereas under the Provincial Parks and Conservation Reserves Act, 2006, S.O. 2006, c.12, Subsection 35 (2) of that Act provides that the superintendent in charge of a provincial park may enter into agreements for the development and operation of facilities and the provision of services in respect of the park;

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha deems it desirable to enter into a licence of occupation agreement to permit the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks access and use of the subject area to construct, own and maintain a dock that will encroach and occupy part of the Township lands being part of the original shore road allowance along the shoreline of Rathbun Lake, adjacent to Lot 13, Concession 6 for the free use of the public and will aid visitors in their recreational enjoyment of the Kawartha Highlands Provincial Park;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha enacts as follows:

1. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a location of occupation agreement with His Majesty The King In Right Of Ontario represented by the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks and affix the corporate seal thereto;
2. That the said Agreement, shall be knows as Schedule “A” and attached to this by-law.
3. That this bylaw shall repeal By-law 2014-0097, passed the 2nd day of September, 2014 as the previous Licence of Occupation Agreement expired on December 31, 2024.

This by-law shall come into effect on the 1st day of January, 2025.
