Subject: Supply and Application of Crushed Limestone Aggregate Tender

Recommendation:

That Council directs staff to enter into an agreement with Drain Brothers Excavating for the supply and application of crushed limestone aggregate.

Background:

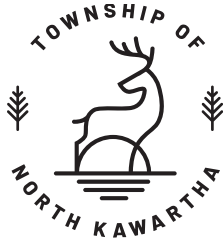
On March 24, 2025 a tender was issued (RFT-03-25) for the supply and application of 5/8 granular limestone aggregate. The tender divided the Municipality into four strategic areas, one of which was a Municipal stockpile at the Public Works yard. The tender closed on April 17, 2025.

Analysis:

One bid was received by Drain Brothers Excavating Limited. I have included the proponents bid per area below:

Area	Product	Quantity	Unit Price/Tonne
Woodview	Granular M 5/8	3550 Tonnes	\$13.65 + HST
Chandos	Granular M 5/8	7800 Tonnes	\$16.40 + HST
Apsley	Granular M 5/8	1925 Tonnes	\$14.82 + HST
Stockpile	Granular M 5/8	1200 Tonnes	\$14.82 + HST
Stockpile	2 inch Breaker Run	N/A	\$14.52 + HST

The quantities included in the above spreadsheet are for gravel resurfacing of roads identified in the 2025 Capital Budget as well as aggregate required for the “5 Year Surface Treatment Plan”. The rows identified as “stockpile” are for spot repairs and culvert installations.



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Financial Implications:

The proponent met all of the requirements of RFT-03-25 and also provided a Gradation Test report indicating the product meets the requirements of OPSS 1010.
