

The Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha

By-law 2025-0058

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha to amend Procedure By-Law 2025-0050.

Whereas Section 9 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25 provides that the municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

And Whereas Section 238 (2) of the Municipal Act requires that every municipality and local board shall pass a procedure by-law for governing the calling, place and proceedings of meetings.

And Further Whereas Council adopted Procedure By-law 2025-0050 on the 15th day of July, 2025 and deems expedient to amend Section 10.6 and Section 11.5;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha enacts as follows:

1. That the following section be added:

Section 10. 6 Notice -Emergency Meetings

- 1) No public notice is required for an Emergency Meeting

For the purposes of this section, an Emergency meeting refers to an emergency within the meaning of the Emergency Response Plan.

2. That **Section 11.5 Repeal** be amended to replace By-Law 2022-0016 with By-Law 2023-0075.
3. 6.1 Order of Business
 5. Remove Adoption of Planning By-Laws (as they are now read at the end of the meeting)
4. 12. New Business and Unfinished Business (includes Notice of Motion and Announcements) – remove Announcements as it is now item 15.
5. Remove 6.13 e) Announcements
6. 6.14 By-laws
 - Remove from Section 6.1 4) a) every proposed by-law listed on the agenda under statutory public meetings may be considered by a single motion, all other

This by-law shall come into effect on the 16th day of September, 2025.
