A By-Law to adopt a Policy to Govern the Display of Banners in the Township of North Kawartha

Whereas under Section 8 (1) of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, c 25, as amended the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

And Whereas under Section 8 (3) (a) of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended a municipality may regulate or prohibit respecting the matter;

And Further Whereas the Municipality deems it necessary to set out a process for regulating the displaying of over street and pole banners;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha enacts as follows:

1. That the Policy to Govern the Display of Banners be adopted and attached hereto and form part of this by-law.
2. That any of the prescribed provisions of this by-law and policy may be modified by resolution of Council where it is established that strict compliance with the terms hereof would be unnecessary, inapplicable, or inappropriate in the circumstances
3. That the provisions of any policies contrary to this by-law be hereby repealed.

Read a First, Second and Third time and passed in Open Council on the 18th day of June, 2013.
